The ANGELE ALINE 300

In 1940 Angele Aline saved the lives of 300 soldiers by rescuing them from the port of Dunkirk during ‘Operation Dynamo’.

In order to Gift Aid your donation you must pay an amount of UK Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax during the financial year at least equal to the Tax reclaimed.
